

# On Licence

Section 14 to 16, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Wild On Waiheke Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **82 Onetangi Road Waiheke Island Auckland** and known as **Wild On Waiheke**, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises to dine.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only while the premises are being operated as a restaurant, and only during the following days and hours:

**Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 12.00 midnight**

### AND

Alcohol in tasting sizes may be sold on the premises, and only during the following days and hours:

**Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 12.00 midnight**

### AND

Alcohol may be sold only to persons attending any event, private reception, function or other social gathering, and only on the following days and hours:

**Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 12.00 midnight**

### AND

Alcohol may be sold only to persons partaking in archery or laser claybird shooting, and only on the following days and hours:

**Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 9.00pm**

- (c) Drinking water must be freely available to customers from:
  - (i) a self-service water station located on the premises; and
  - (ii) by way of table service when customers are seated to dine.
- (d) The host responsibility statement dated 30 November 2023 must be complied with.
- (e) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- (f) The licensee must ensure that an A4 sign stating the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons is prominently displayed in two places so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- (g) The whole of the premises is **undesigned**.
- (h) The licensed premises are more precisely identified as outlined in the plan date stamped as received by Auckland Council on **22 September 2023**.

## DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

**This licence expires at the close of 29 October 2026 unless renewed.**

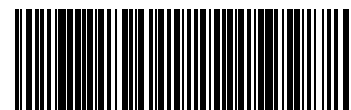
